Mopa (Goa) Airport



- ❖ Mopa Airport traffic continues to trend upwards & handled YTD Pax traffic of ~4.0 mn Pax
 - ✓ Cumulative Pax traffic since operation crossed 4.6 mn Pax mark (Period: Jan 5, 2023 – Feb 29, 2024)
- ❖ Qatar Airways announced commencement of its operations from Mopa Airport effective 20 June, 2024 to deliver improved passenger experience
 - ✓ To operate direct daily flight between Goa (GOX) & Doha (DOH)
- ❖ FLY91, is the first Indian airline to use Mopa Airport, Goa as it's home base and operate flights to Agatti, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Jalgaon, Pune, Nanded and Sindhudurg in India in first phase
 - ✓ Inaugural flight flagged off between Goa (GOX) and Agatti Islands, Lakshadweep on March 12, 2024
 - ✓ Schedule flights will commence effective from March 18, 2024 between Mopa Airport, Goa and Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Jalgaon, Agatti, Pune, Nanded and from Bengaluru, Hyderabad and Pune to Sindhudurg, Jalgaon, Nanded and Goa, in a phased manner
