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## **I. Introduction**

Climate change refers to long-term shifts in temperatures and weather patterns in local, regional, and global climates. Climate change is characterized by the changes in climatic parameters such as temperature, precipitation, wind speed etc. due to increased concentration of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions generated majorly through human activities.

This increased concentration of GHG emission has resulted in global warming which is posing a serious threat to our planet. While the environmental degradation is evident through multiple catastrophic climate events which continue to cause significant socio-economic damage across the world, collective actions must be taken globally by all stakeholders including Businesses, Society and Regulatory bodies.

GMR Group understands the seriousness of climate change and the risks associated with it. We are committed to reducing carbon footprints and minimizing impacts with climate resilience programs that have mitigation and adoption strategies at all our establishments.

## **II. Scope**

This policy shall apply to all establishments of GMR Group and to our value chain partners. Each employee shall be made a partner in implementing the policy.

## **III. Our Commitment**

GMR Group Companies' undeterred focus on good corporate governance is strengthened by our commitment to reduce carbon emissions and take actions to minimize climate change impacts at all our establishments. We believe that environmentally sustainable and being responsible in business conduct are a key part of our good governance practices which will empower us to help in creating a resilient and sustainable world.

GMR Group is committed to aligning its climate mitigation efforts with national and global ambitions of limiting global warming rise to 1.50°C as per the Paris Agreement.

We are committed to addressing climate change problems through effective mitigation and adoption strategies based on an understanding of vulnerabilities, risks, and uncertainties for the business.

Through the Climate Resilience Policy, GMR Group aims to:

- 1) reduce the organization's carbon footprint.
- 2) set and achieve net zero carbon emission targets with a program.
- 3) encourage and provide impetus to natural resource conservation, green infrastructure development, energy efficiency & energy conservation, renewable energy use, green transportations, operational efficiency, sustainable procurements, and use of Biofuels & Sustainable Aviation Fuels.

- 4) encourage our value chain partners/stakeholders to adopt green initiatives and practices on climate actions.
- 5) asses and address climate change risk and opportunities periodically.
- 6) encourage effective communication on climate risks and opportunities through capacity building and awareness.

#### **IV. Policy Statement**

The GMR Group of Companies is an infrastructure conglomerate which relies on its employees, suppliers, value chain partners, and other stakeholders for business continuity; takes cognizance that climate change risks can impact its operations.

We take climate change risks into consideration when we assess organizational risks and have put business continuity plans and climate action plans in place. We assess, identify, analyze, and prioritize the impacts of climate change risks and opportunities through detailed scenario analysis and risk management procedures in line with globally recognized standards.

In case of any amendment(s), clarification(s), circular(s) etc. issued by the relevant authorities, not being consistent with the provisions laid down under this Policy, then such amendment(s), clarification(s), circular(s) etc. shall prevail notwithstanding the provisions hereunder from the effective date as laid down under such amendment(s), clarification(s), circular(s) etc. and shall be deemed to be part of this policy.
